

On the Motion of the Chairman (Mr. Byrnes H.)
Seconded by Mr. Muehlan it was unanimously
Resolved - That we strongly disapprove
of the action of those responsible for the recent rising
in Dublin.

That we firmly believe the constitutional
movement under the leadership of Mr. John B. Redmond
is the only way to peace and prosperity
in Ireland.

That we appeal to Mr. Redmond and
the Irish Party to ask the Government to extend
the same clemency to the Irish prisoners who took
part in the recent revolt as was extended to the West
and his followers in the South African rebellion and
that we believe we are voicing the feelings of
all sections of the Irish people when we say
that enough blood has been shed and homes
made desolate in the country and strongly urge
on the Government the necessity for disarming
all civilian forces in Ulster and other parts of
Ireland.

That our Clerk convey a copy of this
resolution to Mr. John B. Redmond M.P. and to Mr.
Whitty M.P. member for North Louth.
