

IRISH VOLUNTEERS.

The following resolution submitted by the Limerick County Council, was adopted:—

Proposed by Mr Edward Goodman;

Seconded by Mr Michael Meade, and

Resolved—That owing to recent political events, and particularly to the attitude of the army on the Ulster question, we, the members of the Louth County Council, consider that the time has come when effort should be made to organise the Irish Volunteer Force in every parish in Ireland. We are convinced that such a force, wisely led by men in whom our indomitable leader, Mr J E Redmond, would have confidence, would prove to the world that the manhood of Ireland are ready to do their part in defence of their homes and their liberties, and if need be, to protect our fellow-Nationalists in Ulster from insult and attack.
