

Deed of conveyance of the Commissioners of Church Temporalities in Ireland (Diocese of Armagh, Benefice of Ardee) to Patrick Maguinness, farmer, of Ardee County Louth, granting Maguinness a holding in the town of Ardee, barony of Ardee, county Louth, consisting of 33 perches statute measure for the sum of £25 sterling. Dated 6 October 1874

We, The Commissioners of Church Temporalities in Ireland, under the authority of an act passed in the thirty second and thirty third years of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria Chapter forty two, shortly intituled "The Irish Church Act 1869," in consideration of the sum of Twenty five pounds Sterling by Patrick Maguinness of Ardee in the County of Louth Farmer paid into the Banks of Ireland to our account, Do grant unto the said Patrick Maguinness All that holding now in his possession containing, thirty three perches statute measure or thereabouts in the town of Ardee, Barony of Ardee and County of Louth with the appurtenances, To hold the same unto the said Patrick Maguinness his heirs and assigns for ever. Subject to such rights of Common, rights of way, and other easements if any, as now affect the said premises In witness whereof We the said Commissioners of Church Temporalities in Ireland have hereunto affixed our Corporate Seal this Sixth day of October one thousand eight hundred and seventy four,
