	This Council also affirms that we will not support any trade agreement that includes Investor-State Dispute mechanisms.	
	This Council recognises with vigilance the construction of a Regulatory Co-operation Council through TTIP and affirms the position that this body's authority and remit should allow only for recommendation. Implementation of recommendations should be administered by those elected by and accountable to the citizens of Europe.This Council does not support any trade mechanism that allows Irish law to be superseded for corporate interest."
