To date, no-one has been charged with his killing. A number of suspects in the killing were serving members of the Ulster Defence Regiment of the British Army. This state has failed to properly investigate the murder of one of its citizens. It has also failed the wider Ludlow family through the manner in which the investigation into Seamus Ludlow's murder was conducted. Louth County Council calls: on the Government to establish the two Commissions of Investigation recommended by the Joint Oireachtas Committee in 2006. on the Garda Commissioner and the Police Ombudsman in the North to meet with the family."
