16.0 Notice of Motion - Cllr. A. McKeivitt

" Calling on Louth County Council to postpone the vote on the introduction of the Draft Development Plan and extend the date until the end of March whereby submissions can be received from the public to change or amend the plan. This request is in light of the Covid-19 restrictions and public health and safety concerns. The citizens of County Louth deserve the right to meet and discuss the impacts of the new proposals, by postponing; citizens will be given the right to have their voices heard. "

17.0 Notice of Motion - Cllrs. P. McQuillan & M. Yore

Requesting that Louth County Council write to the Ministers for Justice, Finance and Public Expenditure to make provisions where monies confiscated under the Proceeds of Crime Legislation be redirected from central coffers back into local addiction services, youth organisations, and community initiatives to combat the effect of addiction on our communities, and that the necessary legislation is changed as a matter of urgency to allow this vital funding support to happen.

"Given the ongoing failure to recruit sufficient retained Fire fighters nationwide and allowing for the part-time salary and time commitment associated with the role, that Louth County Council write to the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform asking that members of the public service be allowed to apply for and hold a position as a retained Fire fighter while remaining to work in the public service in the interest of public safety".

19.0 Notice of Motion - Cllr. P. Smith

"This Council welcomes and supports the recent announcement by the Minister For Defence that an Independent Review Board will be appointed to examine all aspects of the battle of Jadotville involving A Company, 35th Infantry Battalion of the Irish Defence Forces ONUC contingent. Furthermore, we ask that the review board include expert historians, professional military personnel including a senior non commissioned officer and that the review will examine and report on the psychological effects of the battle on the military personnel involved"

"That Louth County Council assesses the extent of recycling bins marked for clothing located in the county on both public and private land. That the Council circulate information to members on whether permission is required for these bins, many of which are beside bottle banks on the public realm.
