18.0 Notice of Motion - Cllr. Paula Butterly

I call on this Chamber to pass a motion whereby a review is conducted of all of the protected structures on the Record of Protected Structures in County Louth with immediate effect, focusing in equal measures on urban, rural buildings and their curtilages.

Said review is to be completed within twelve months of the passing of this motion and a list of protected structures, containing no less than one hundred structures, is to be brought before the Chamber on a quarterly basis for review and approval by the Members.

1. Installation of Mobile Hoists: The Council commits to installing mobile hoists in all public swimming pools to provide safe access for individuals with disabilities. This will ensure that our facilities comply with national accessibility standards and promote equal access to recreational services.

This Council acknowledges the importance of creating a safer and healthier environment in Drogheda, particularly for younger people, by advancing the development of sustainable transportation infrastructure. Therefore, the Council will review the current status of the three Active Travel Schemes to establish a safe, segregated cycling route from the PANCR/M1 Retail Park to the SouthGate Shopping Centre; provide timely updates on the progress of these schemes, including the outcomes of consultations that concluded last year; prioritize their swift implementation for the safety of residents, especially school children and commuters; and develop a connectivity plan to link schools and critical areas to this cycling route, ensuring it serves as a central, accessible pathway for all residents.
