This notice of motion is seeking the support of the elected members of the Borough District of Drogheda and the Executive to rededicate the Bridge of Peace as the Saint Oliver Plunkett Bridge of Peace.

This motion is set down in the 400th anniversary year of the birth of Saint Oliver and the 50th anniversary of his being elevated to Sainthood as the patron saint of peace and reconciliation on the Island of Ireland. The symbolism of this rededication on the bridge crossing the River Boyne in the town which holds the honour of being the location of the national shrine to Saint Oliver.
