6.0 Motion - Cllr. Pio Smith

“Calling on this Borough District to provide a detailed report on the works carried out under the Drogheda Streetscape Improvements as outlined in the 2019 LCC Budget under the heading of Operations & Local Services 3 Year Capital Programme 2019-2021, specifically stating the type of work carried out and the cost of each piece of work and make a statement on the matter.”
