“That this council, as part of the €12m restoration works on the Fair Street Council Offices, commits to the installation of a Changing Places Ireland facility in its restoration. As it stands, the current standards of disabled toilets in the town do not meet the needs of all people with disabilities. This facility would ensure that those with specific needs are not excluded from participating in social, cultural and economic activities. I would also encourage the council to work with Disability Louth to ensure the facility meets the needs of the disability community.”
