Consideration of new applications:

Name of Applicant: Viaduct Developments Ltd
Location: Bridgeford, Newfoundwell Road, Drogheda
Planning Reference: 18280

Proposed Names:

1. Bridgeford
2. An Tobar
3. Bridge Rise
4. Newfoundwell Rise

Helen noted that there are three houses North of the site known as Bridgeford Rise, which may cause confusion with services etc.

After discussion, the committee agreed, by vote, that **"An Tobar"** would be adopted going forward.

Location: Greenore Road, Carlingford

Proposed Names:

1. Shilties Row
2. Delacy Court

Brendan confirmed that Shilties Lough is close to the site. Helen identified one house across the road named "Shilties" and the field next door to the site is also known as "Shilties" field.

Following discussion, Tomas proposed the name **"Shilties Court"** which was seconded by Joanna.

Location: St Johns Home, Peters Hill, Drogheda
Planning Reference: 19839

Proposal: To retain the address of the development as St. John Home and numbering the new 4 no. 1 bed units as No's 1-4 St. Johns Home, Peters Hill, Drogheda.

Following discussion, Joanna proposed to retain the name "St Johns Home" and numbering 1-4 of the units, which was seconded by Kieran.

Helen confirmed that Listoke was 1.5km North of this site and the townland of Ballymakenny was not in the immediate area. With regard to the proposal to sub divide individual areas within the development, Kieran outlined that An Post would prefer the address line to reflect 1 name and have no sub-division.

It was felt by the committee that the area which is covered by the proposed name "Tullybrook Walk" was linked to "Tullybrook Court". It was suggested that the 8 houses in "Tullybrook Walk" should be extended into "Tullybrook Court" and numbered 1-28 (number 1 being the 1st house upon entry to the estate).

Following this discussion, Tomas proposed the names "Tullybrook Place, Tullybrook Way & Tullybrook Court (1-28)" which were seconded by Joanna.

It was felt by the Committee that "Glen" was already used in numerous developments in both Dundalk and Drogheda and the development was in the Townland of Marshes Upper. It was also felt that the proposal of the inclusion of the name "Block" in the address line was un-necessary in this instance.

Following discussion, Tomas proposed the name "**Marshes Upper**" with one sequence of numbers (1-65) which was seconded by Joanna.

Name of Applicant: Darrabridge Housing Ltd
Location: Stoney Lane, Ardee
Planning Reference: 19553

Proposed Names:

1. Lan na Galla
2. Lána Clocha
3. Lána Stoney

Tomas outlined that the name Lána na gCloch was Irish for Stoney Lane, however, this is the name of the road, which the development is situated. An alternative would be Clós na gCloch (Stoney Close).

Following this discussion, Dolores proposed the name "**Clós na gCloch**" which was seconded by Tomas.

Re-consideration of previous application discussed "The Kitchen Garden"

Following a request from the developer/agent, the committee re-considered the name of the development at the Demesne, Dundalk. The historical context of the original name "The Kitchen Garden" along with further options regarding history & location were discussed.

Following discussion Tomas proposed the name "**Dúiche Roden**" with one sequence of numbers (1-122) which was seconded by Kieran.
