Name of Applicant: **Dwellings Development Ltd**
Location: Termonfeckin Rd, Newtownstalaban, Drogheda
Planning Reference: 22/877

Proposed Names: Beaulieu Brook -

The existing stream forms an integral part of our development, and has been designed as such, creating an expansive linear gateway along the entire western and southern boundary. This stream also feeds the Beaulieu House Estate before entering the River Boyne/Boyne Estuary

There is no other scheme with this name in Co Louth

Following discussion, Cllr. John Sheridan proposed that **Beaulieu Stream** (rather than Brook) be accepted, but an Irish translation of Beaulieu Stream should be obtained from Cllr Sharkey to be use alongside. Both names to be sent as a suggestion to the applicant. Cllr. Conor Keelan seconded.

Name of Applicant: **Apollo Seven One Properties Limited**

Location: North Road, Moneymore, Drogheda
Planning Reference: 22/1018

Proposed Names: Seven Winds

The subject site contains agricultural land and the site of a house. The house was owned since mid 19th century by one family and was called Seven Winds, the area was locally known as Seven Winds. Proof of use was provided by the developer.

Following discussion, Cllr. John Sheridan proposed that **Seven Winds** be accepted but to be used with an Irish version of the name, Cllr Sharkey to be asked to provide. This is to be suggested to the applicant. Seconded by Cllr. Conor Keelan.
