The Cathaoirleach Pio Smith welcomed Members back to the Meeting to consider the Chief Executive's Report on Submissions Received to the Proposed Material Alterations on the Draft Louth Co. Dev. Plan. The Cathaoirleach then requested the Meeting's Administrator go through the protocols for meetings and carry out a roll call.

Gráinne Tuomey, Meeting Administrator outlined the procedures for remote meeting participation, in line with the Council's adopted Standing Orders and reminded Members of their Statutory Obligations

concerning Ethical Framework, Disclosure at Meetings, Disclosure in Advance of Meetings and the Code of Conduct for Councillors.

Members were reminded of the need to have a quorum of 9 Members present at all times and an attendance roll call was held.

Senior Planner Joanna Kelly advised members that they were here purely to attend to the report at hand. Members were advised that a further modification to a Material Alteration may be made only where it is minor in nature and therefore not likely to have significant effects on the environment or adversely affect the integrity of a European Site, and shall not be made where it relates to an increase in the area of land zoned for any purpose or an addition to or deletion from the record of protected structures. In making the Development Plan, Councillors were advised they are restricted to considering the proper planning and sustainable development of the area to which the development plan relates, the statutory obligations of the local authority and any relevant policies or objectives of the Government or any Minister of the Government.

Members were cautioned that if they were to put forward reasons at variance with core strategy or planning and sustainable development guidelines, this would be put in minutes and forwarded to the OPR who might very well seek a Ministerial Direction and the Executive would find it very hard to defend anything that goes against the core strategy.
