Programme Updates

St. Nicholas' Church of Ireland, Dundalk



In May 2025, A planning decision was received for the proposed capital works to St Nicholas' Church of Ireland, Dundalk. Planning permission was granted for these works to proceed as planned. The procurement for these capital works will begin in Q1 2026.

Battle of The Boyne Site

In June 2025, an Appropriate Assessment Screening of the site for the proposed capital works at the Battle of The Boyne Site was carried out and concluded the works would not have a significant impact on the environmental integrity of the River Boyne area, therefore a stage 2 Appropriate Assessment and a Natura Impact Statement is not required. This outcome will allow us to proceed with the procurement as planned in Q4 2025.





Procurement
