LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SANITARY SERVICES) ACT, 1948, (No. 3 of 1948)

COUNTY HEALTH DISTRICT OF LOUTH

THE LOUTH COUNTY COUNCIL being the Sanitary Authority for the County Health District of Louth and being of the opinion that the erection or retention of temporary dwellings on the lands described in the schedule hereto would be prejudicial to public health in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in them by Section 31 of the Local Government (Sanitary Services) Act, 1948 (No. 3 of 1948) and of every other power and authority in this behalf them enabling Do Herby Order that the erection or retention of temporary dwellings on land or water with the several areas described in the Schedule hereto be and same Is Hereby Prohibited.

SCHEDULE

- a) Parts of the Townlands of Port, Lurganboy, Labanstown, Cruicestown, Reynoldstown, Mayne, Callystown being the areas contained between the red line marked on the map Number 1 attached hereto, and the coastline.
- b) Part of the Townlands of Glaspistol and Callystown being the areas contained between the red line on the map marked Number 2, and attached hereto, and the coastline.

All the lands in Parts a and b of this Schedule are situate in the County Health District of Louth.

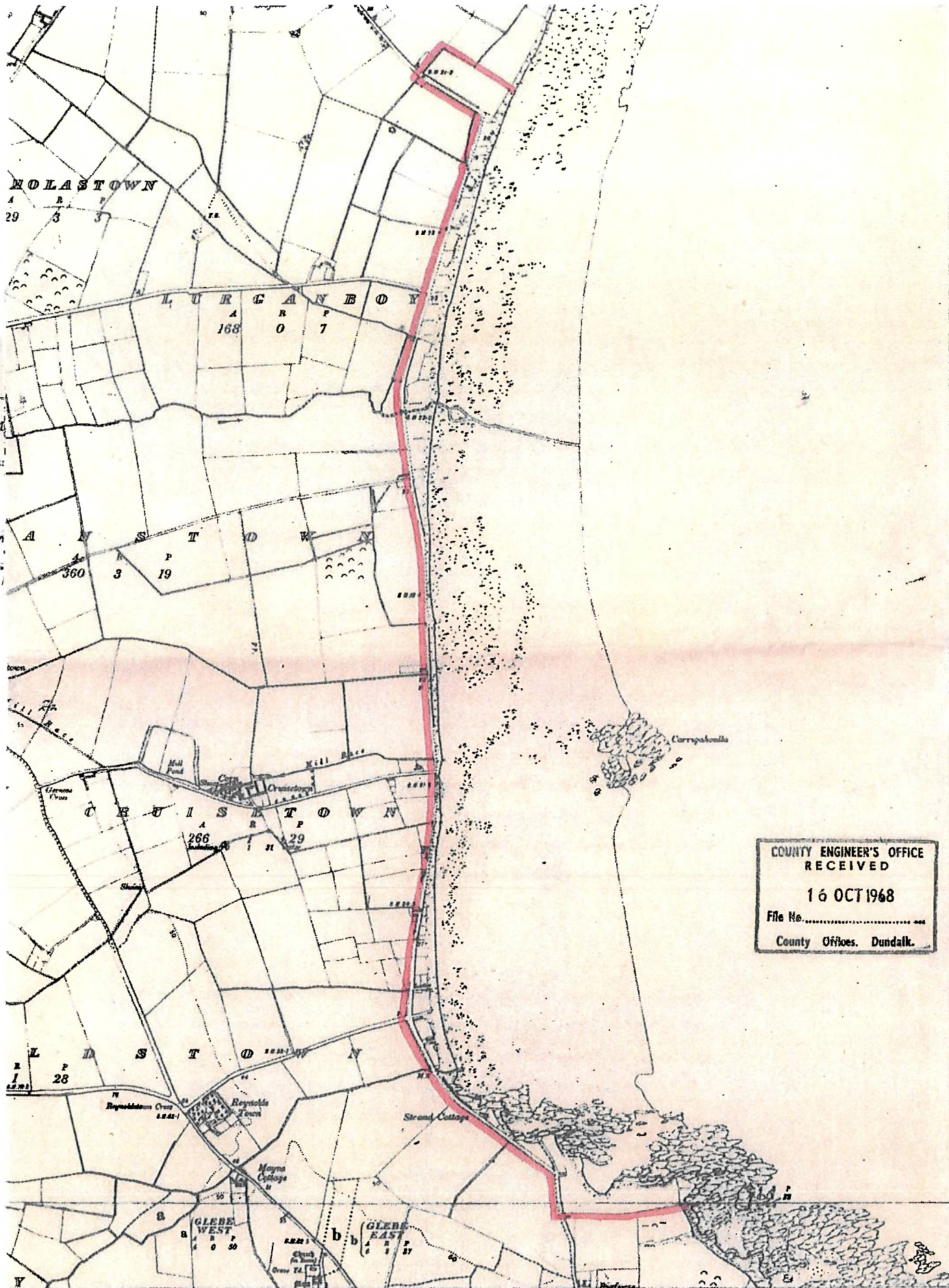
